Rules:

Jars and lids must be clean and free from damage before starting.

Jars must be filled correctly (almost to the top, or roughly 0.5cm from the top of the jar)

Jams and jellies must be home and handmade by the entrant. No commercial entrants or those that are made in exchange for money

Judging Criteria:

Appearance –

- Colour – characteristic of fruit, clearness
- Jellies – translucence
- Container – glass, practical, clean sealed lids.

Texture –

- Jelly – tender, should quiver, cut easily and retain shape, no crystals.
- Jams – crushed fruit, no separation of fruit and juice and a good set.

Flavour –

- Characteristic, without excessive sweetness or overcooked flavour

Scoring: Total Score of 20 possible points

- Flavour & aroma (7)
- Consistency, texture, quantity (6)
- Colour (5)
- Container – cover, label and appearance (2)
